HOW TO HOST A FREEDOM GATHERING

First of all, thank you! Your interest in hosting a Freedom Gathering in support of the work of Traffick911 and your desire to join the fight against child sex trafficking means the world to us. We hope this guide helps you prepare, host and follow up on an event that makes your guests aware of the issue of child sex trafficking and the mission of Traffick911. Please use this guide as you plan your event.

Step 1: Ask

Life is always more fun with friends, so ask a few to host with you! Everything will be easier and more fun if you work together. Freedom Gatherings are about the power of community so involve those closest to you.

Step 2: Set a Date

Pick a date and a location and start working toward it!

Step 3: Invite

You're ready to invite. Create your invitation so it tells your guests why you're hosting the dinner, who they'll be helping, what the menu will be, and of course time and date. Personally invite your friends and family to fill the table and share about the impact the dinner is making, not just for those trapped in human trafficking, but for your community too. There is something powerful that happens when people feel a personal connection.

Step 4: Request

Email Susie@Traffick911.com to request event materials (orientation packets, donation envelopes and printed informational materials). If you have a large group and would like a Traffick911 representative to attend your dinner, you may also visit our website and complete the speaker request form. Please make this request at least four weeks before your event.

Step 5: Plan

Begin to plan your menu and timeline of your event. Will you do a brunch, a dinner or a wine and cheese night? Be creative in the details and consider your guests.

Step 6: Set a Goal

Have a fundraising goal in mind as you plan your event. Engaging people to reach the target effectively sets a sense of achievement and goodwill to make the goal a reality.

Step 7: Prepare Remarks

Prepare to share your own story of becoming passionate about abolishing human trafficking, how you became involved with Traffick911 and why you want them to get involved in the movement. Remind your guests about your fundraising goals and don't be afraid to ask for donations. The impact of your guests will truly impact the life of a child.

Things to think about...

- Set a table for Traffick911 print materials and encourage people to sign up for our mailing list
- Consider showing a documentary (or a short clip) at your event
- Ask your employer if they will do a matching gift
- Give guests the option to give even if they can't attend your event
- Let us know ahead of time that you are planning an event by emailing Susie@Traffick911.com. We are here to support you!

Sample Event Timeline

6:00pm: Greet your guests as they arrive

Set aside the first hour for guests to meet, catch up and enjoy some refreshments. This will allow for any guests running late to arrive in time for your presentation.

7:00pm: Begin gathering your guests to be seated

7:15pm: Introductions

7:20pm: Share with your guests the reasons why you care about the issue of child sex

trafficking and your passion for this work.

7:30pm: Show documentary clip or Traffick911 video

7:50pm: Discuss why the issue of sex trafficking is moving you to action, how you heard

about Traffick911 and why the work of Traffick911 makes a difference.

If you have set a fundraising goal, inform your guests of this goal and the reason behind it. Invite your guests to support Traffick911 and explain that monthly giving is the best way friends and family can support the work. Please follow that up with how any financial support makes a difference and is deeply appreciated. Make sure people know where to leave their donation and consider having a laptop set up with www.traffick911/donate.
